Spray park equipment can eliminate



inate those fears since the zero depth system has an intense drainage system

that does not allow water to build up on the surface of the play area. This lets even the youngest of children play freely and



enjoy the water while their parents can have relief in the fact that the risks of injury or drowning have been greatly minimized.

Spray parks also cut out the expense for having to staff lifeguards, and expensive maintenance systems. This takes a financial load off of owners and allows the spray park equipment to be used for longer periods of time during summer months, without extra cost. Another great benefit of this equipment is the water conservation value. Most systems are motion activated so they are not

continuously running if there are no children playing, and many systems also offer re-circulating options. This helps to conserve water and even keep the amount of water that is required less than the standard swimming pool, saving on long term cost as well.
